A 9.0 magnitude earthquake on December 26 caused tidal waves that have claimed over 80,000 lives in South Asia. The number of people who are homeless exceeds our imagination. Total communities collapsed in the blinking of an eye. More than ten (10) nations experienced destruction and death. The United Methodist Church began responding immediately through our ecumenical partners.






### UNITED METHODIST WOMEN'S REPORT

- Help me find my place in the service. I will not find your help an intrusion. In fact, I will remember your kindness.
- Speak to me during the coffee hour. I know you want to see your friends and settle that piece of committee business. But I may find it hard to believe that you truly care for each other unless I first see evidence that you care for "the stranger in you midst."
